Cardiovascular History

Common Presenting Complaints

Elicit onset, location, quality, duration, affecting factors, assoc symptoms for each.

Commonly:

- Chest pain
- Dyspnoea exertional, at rest, orthopnoea, PND
- · Ankle swelling
- Palpitations
- Syncope, pre-syncope, or dizziness
- Fatique
- Intermittent claudication

Specific Risk Factors

IHD:

- Previous Hx of IHD/PVD/CVA
- Big 5: ↑Cholesterol, smoking, HT, DM, FHx
- Others: Male, >55y, Obesity, ^homocysteine, renal failure

Past Medical History

Prev IHD, coronary surgery, stents RhF, STD, recent dental work, thyroid disease Medications

Family History

MI, cardiomyopathy, congenital heart disease, MVP, Marfan's

Social History

Smoking, EtOH, IVDA
Occupation
Exercise tolerance – stairs at home

Other

NYHA Class:

- I -asymptomatic disease, or only symptoms (SOB, CP) on intense activity
- II symptoms on ordinary activity
- III symptoms on less than ordinary activity
- IV symptoms at rest
